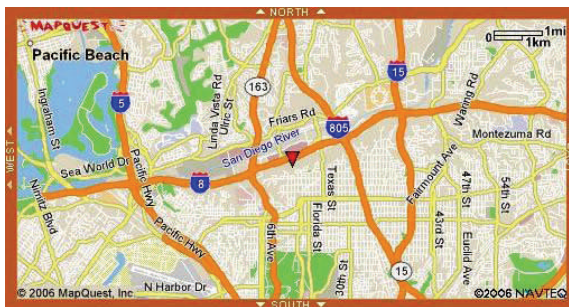

From South

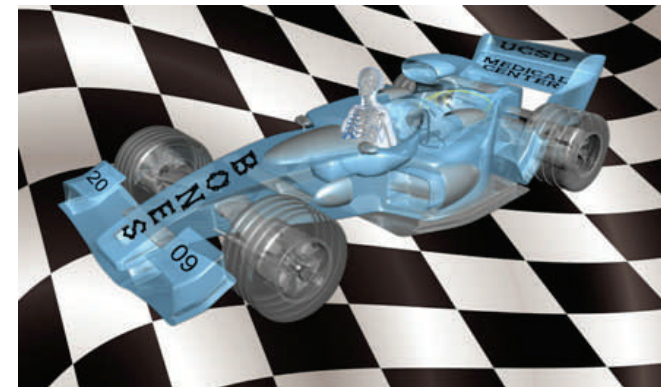
